OUR NEW ZERO WASTE EDUCATION PROGRAMME

Recently we have adopted the new **Zero Waste Education** programme developed by EERST (Environmental Education for Resource Sustainability).

This programme builds on what has previously been covered by the **Slash Trash & Waste Not** education programmes.

The **Zero Waste Education** programme incorporates a very successful education campaign currently being delivered all over New Zealand.
